Thank you for participating in this survey. Before we begin, we would like to assure you that your privacy and confidentiality are of utmost importance to us. Please take a moment to read the following privacy statement:

Throughout this Notice, “University” “we”, “our” and “us” refers to the University of Leeds. “you” and “your” refers to all other individuals involved in research and innovation activity.

Purpose:

Data Sharing:
